

I guess I didn't expect to but I learned quite a bit reading this book. Written in a true confessions style, it's a revealing and very human account of a personal odyssey into spiritual discovery, replete with unsentimental observations and sharp wit, plus plenty of sex, drugs & rave music to keep things spiced-up. Along the wild and wacky way, the book also reveals that the author did serious homework on Gnostic Christianity, mysticism, Sufism, quantum physics, yoga and various healing modalities. His deep interest in the meaning of the Cosmos and his basic sincerity of heart shine through his journey of struggles with skepticism, the pain of depression, and a petulance which he doesn't deny. As he continues to suspend doubt and open himself to the possibilities of other dimensions of reality (incl. aliens!), a concurrent expansion takes place in his self-comprehension and he ends the book seeming more at peace with himself and the nature of reality. Going along on his journey of maturity is a fun and thought-provoking ride. Phillips is a talented, intelligent writer and could be one of the next important voices of his generation.

Jesus a quick read simply because I couldn't put it down! If you're looking for a dry boring read on what Gnosticism is and how it works then you'll be disappointed. What will grab and keep your attention is the story. This book is about one man's journey of learning through himself. It is for those who know deep inside that something is going on that mainstream religions can't cope with and science is only beginning to try to understand. If you are struggling with accepting what your experiences are telling you is true, then read this book and realize you are NOT crazy and NOT alone!! Reading it was an affirmation of many of my own experiences and feelings that I've had since I was young and am only now finding words to express and courage to explore.

Talat Phillips has experienced more living in his relatively short lifetime than probably most people twice his age. He has shared these experiences in an open and thought provoking memoir that was an enjoyable read. Talat also brings to his story a refreshing honesty about several topics that might be viewed by many in our society as "woo woo". However, it is my belief that if we do not open ourselves to learning about new experiences and new ideas, we become nothing more than a person "sleep walking" through our lives. Prisoners to a "materialistic" worldview, that limits our potential. So, that is why even though I am old enough to be Talat's mother, I am always looking for books that tackle subjects that will open my heart and mind to new possibilities. "The Electric Jesus" is just that kind of book. If you are a person, who like me, intuitively feels that something is just not right about the way we are living in our current materialistic society, then I think you would not only enjoy reading Talat's story, but it may possibly prove to be a potential springboard for you to consider making changes in your own life.
