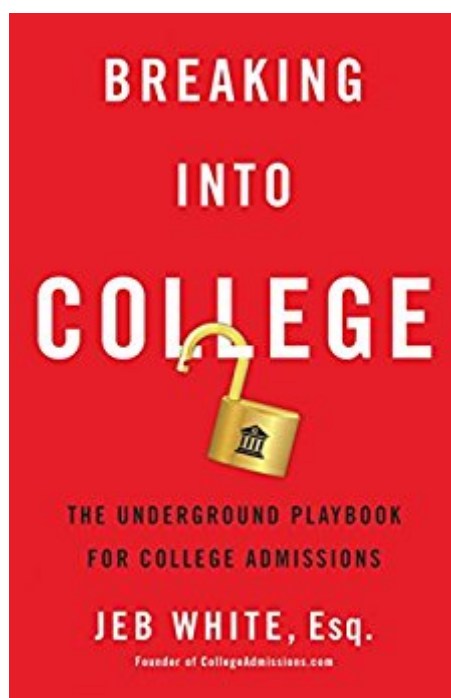

As a high school teacher, my students are constantly being asked BIG life questions, at the ripe age of 15: "where are you applying," "what do you want to do," "did you get in?" Often, they try to navigate the choppy waters of the college admissions process, which can be difficult even the adults trying to help them. Along comes this book as a lighthouse beacon to help students, their

families, and even secondary school staff. This book is a gem. It has an easy reading style, in which the author describes his humble beginnings, how his growth mindset has gotten him where he is today, and provides a step-by-step process of how to navigate through the arduous process of college admissions. The author sets a positive tone for the reader and helps guide students to realize that their dreams are achievable. I would absolutely recommend this to students, parents and people that are involved with young people in an advisory role. This book has certainly found a place on my bookshelf in my classroom and I will be sharing it to all of my students.

This book is a product of passion and experience. The author lays out a "case" for getting into college, using key insight, experience, and story. This is not a boring how-to book, but a passionate case of a skilled persuader to help working class families get into college. His writing is engaging and instructive. Each chapter is structured along the lines of a case, as his vocation is a lawyer. This structure translates well to the college experience because a College Admissions Board is very similar to a jury of peers. The author has also robust experience in helping students in families through the process, which gives color and feet to the chapters. Above all, I thoroughly enjoyed reading this book, and parents and teachers will find helpful things in it as well that translate to other areas of life. I would not only highly recommend this to 13-18 year old students, but also to others seeking a second career or going back to school and feel like they are out of the game.

You can tell how much the author cares about helping students apply and get accepted to the right college. As someone who had all the "hooks" and felt the pressures discussed in the book, I got a unique perspective into what other students have to go through. I've worked with children to help them save for college, but this shows that first the student must work to find the right place and get in. The rest will follow. I hope this book helps our future collegiates find the perfect match and get true insight into themselves along their journey.

As someone who has worked in high school education for 20 years, I think this book will be a real asset to any student looking to apply to competitive colleges. The author does a wonderful job framing the college application process in a way that is easy to understand and gives practical and manageable tips for all potential applicants. While it can be helpful to all applicants, it will be invaluable for those with limited access to quality college guidance and advice. I was especially impressed that the book does not let students off the hook in the college application process.
