

In this newly revised and expanded edition, Grant Osborne provides seminary students and working pastors with the full set of tools they need to move from sound exegesis to the development of biblical and systematic theologies and to the preparation of sound, biblical sermons. Osborne contends that hermeneutics is a spiral from text to context--a movement between the horizon of the text and the horizon of the reader that spirals nearer and nearer toward the intended meaning of the text and its significance for today. Well-established as the standard evangelical work in the field since its first publication in 1991, The Hermeneutical Spiral has been updated to meet the needs of a new generation of students and pastors. General revisions have been made throughout, new chapters have been added on Old Testament law and the use of the Old Testament in the New, and the bibliography has been thoroughly updated. Evangelical Divinity School in Deerfield, Illinois. He also serves as series editor for the IVP New Testament Commentary Series, for which he contributed the volume on Romans. He has also written on Revelation for the Baker Exegetical Commentary on the New Testament.

The Hermeneutical Spiral is packed with solid and necessary principles needed for properly interpreting Scripture. Overall this text should be of great value to communicators of the Word of God. The principles elucidated in the book, if properly utilized, should keep one firmly grounded in the original meaning of the text in his or her application of the text. Then and only then will the communicators proclaim the Word of God rather than their own subjective religious opinions. While the book did have its difficulties, Osborne still established his thesis. The reader is left with no doubt that “biblical interpretation entails a spiral from text to context, from its original meaning to its contextualization or significance for the church today.” An example of the difficulties of the book is the chapter on syntax. Although necessary to the interpretive process, the chapter on syntax was too technical and overly academic. Its interaction with communication theory made the chapter a labyrinth of dull scholastic philosophy. The overwhelming information in the chapter has the effect of submerging the reader under a tsunami of translation principles. This is why I consider The Hermeneutical Spiral a category four stars.

This was my first technical (meaty!) introduction to exegesis and hermeneutics, and it has proven invaluable. The various ways in which Osborne presents the steps of hermeneutics (in which he includes exegesis) are sometimes difficult to distinguish from each other, but this is all part of the ambiguity involved in the hermeneutical process.

Many years ago I had Dr. Osborne for a couple classes at TEDS. He is as good as they come in his field. The book reflects his level of scholarship. A great textbook but no casual read. However, if you're serious about interpreting the biblical text correctly, the tools in this particular toolbox will get you well on your way.

Every Bible student needs Hermeneutical help and this is a thorough source from a scholar at the top of NT exegesis. No wild, untested theories, no speculation. Tried and true Bible study processes designed for the advance Bible student but also helpful for those without a Bible or Seminary degree.
