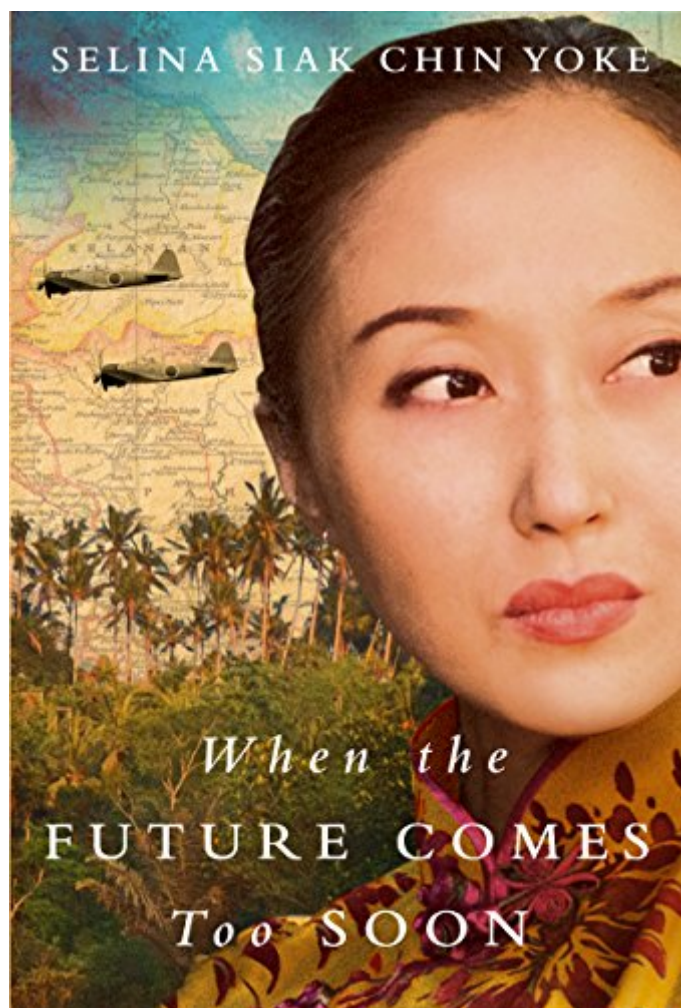


The book was found

Chin Yoke's second book tells of life on the Malay peninsula during the Japanese invasion of WWII. The historical perspective is interesting and the story is well written, but the heroine's circumstances

change abruptly in the last two chapters. After using resourceful courage to provide for her family during years of hardship, she is suddenly deprived of dignity by her capricious husband. I suppose this ending brings home the fact that war dramatically changes the course of people's lives, but I found neither the ending nor its explanation in the epilogue satisfying. Hence the three-star rating.

While I certainly enjoyed this book in the series I have to say it did not live up to the expectations I had after reading the first, *The Woman Who Breathed Two Worlds*. The protagonist mother walked away from an ungrateful, dominating husband, leaving all her children to him and the same life she resented. I felt the book was hurried, so much left out it put gaps in the story and just was too quick a read.

The story was interesting, full of history and carried you easily along. The characters were the best part of the book. They are full of humanity both courageous and strong and full of frailties. You know them and love them well and miss them when the final page is turned. Very good pair of books by this author
