The idea for the Amma, Tell Me series came as a way to introduce her older son, Shiv, to Indian mythology and festivals. This has been another great addition to my Son's collection from Ms.Mathur. The origins of Hanuman have been beautifully told in Part 1 of this series. The illustrator has done a brill job, they do a great job keeping my son engaged.
