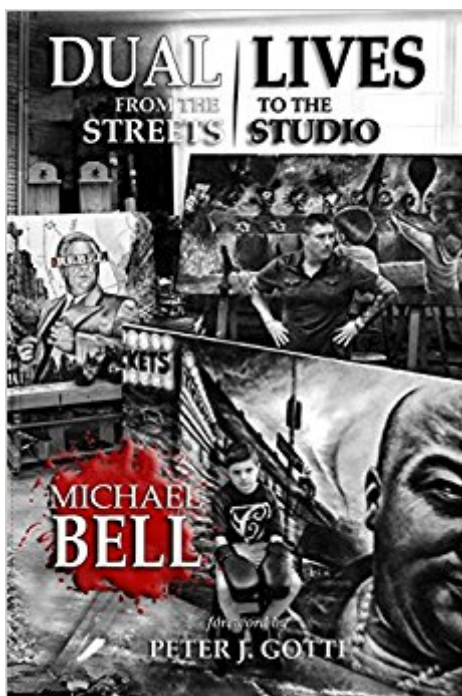


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DUAL LIVES: From The Streets To The Studio



Synopsis

In *Dual Lives*, renowned American artist and 3-time national award-winning "Teacher of the Year" Michael Bell has written an inspiring and brutally candid memoir that chronicles his meteoric rise to becoming one of the most highly decorated public school teachers in America, all the while, living out a storied and often controversial professional painting career as "Mob Artist" to America's most infamous. Go behind the scenes with his intriguing clientele on how these friendships also fueled his career from John Gotti to Al Capone's great-nephew, Dominic Capone to numerous actors from "the Sopranos", "Goodfellas", "A Bronx Tale", and more. This is the ultimate story of overcoming extreme adversity and being a true champion for today's youth from someone still in the trenches, still at the top of his game. His students have earned tens of millions in scholarships; 7 back-to-back NAEA Rising Star Awards in art—an award presented to just one student artist in the entire nation annually; and 8 Scholastic Art National Medalists 3 years straight. Bell also discusses the impact of his family life on his art—on the tragic stillbirth of his sister; on his lifelong relationship with his Grandmother, Violet, a self-taught artist from Lyndhurst, New Jersey; on his inspiring son, Carmen, ("Lil' C"), and his battles with Autism while on his quest to become a Golden Gloves boxing champion. Then there's Bell's notorious cousin Vinnie, who was part of the longest double-murder trial in the history of the State of New Jersey. Learn how Bell, himself, went from being a troubled youth once facing twenty-years-to-life to saving one of his own students from a similar fate nearly two decades later. *Dual Lives* is passionately written, and just as courageously vulnerable as the compelling narratives found within Bell's paintings. Michael Bell is a renowned American Artist, most famous for his gangster series paintings and his infamous portrait painting clientele, which includes John Gotti, Dominic Capone and numerous

actors from "the Sopranos", "Goodfellas", "A Bronx Tale", and more. He's also a father, fighter, boxing enthusiast, anti-bullying and Autism activist. Bell has also excelled in the field of education, playing a vital role in pioneering the worldwide "Visual Journaling" movement. Bell is a National Board Certified Teacher and a 3-time national award-winning public school "Teacher of the Year" that has been honored with: the Los Angeles Good Shepherd Shelter Community Service Award, the College Board's William U. Harris Award of Excellence, the NAEA's National Art Honor Society Sponsor of the Year, the Washington Post's Agnes Meyer Outstanding Teacher Award and the Dr. James E. Douthat Outstanding Achievement Award from Lycoming College. Bell is also a 7-time NAEA Rising Star Award-Winning Art Educator (2010 to 2016) and a 3-time Scholastic Art National Medalist Educator (2014 to 2016). As well as, his beloved son's well being and progress after being diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD). Bell continues to mention that the great irony of existence is what makes life worth living and it does not come from the rosy side. He reminds us that the energy to live comes from the dark side. It comes from everything that makes us suffer. As we struggle against these negative powers,

we're forced to live more deeply, more fully. It's this constant battle that leads us to our fullest potential and most glorious achievement. Dual Lives is a pleasure to read. Bell's style is direct, raw, and lucid. It is written with a great sense of humor too. This warrior welcomes us into his world, his accomplishments, and his battles. You not only feel like a part of his family, but he leaves you wanting another serving of Sunday dinner.

I didn't know what to expect when I picked up this book, had no idea, but I enjoyed it so much I couldn't put it down. It's hard to say in just a few words the way this book touched me. Michael tells his story in a very clear, brutally honest way but with so much love and compassion! Michael, with all his rough edges, makes you not only want to be a better person but makes you realize that you CAN be a better person, leader, parent, friend. I picked up this book for a very personal reason, the chapter entitled "Angelina". Angelina is my daughter and Michael wrote about the time he spent with her dad and I at the hospital when we found out our daughter was going to lose her battle with cancer at the age of 11. One call from Louie, Angelina's dad and Michael left his family with only the clothes on his back and came to Philly to be with us. For 10 days Michael never left us, he slept on the floor of Angelina's room every night for 10 days and he writes about that time in his book. It gave me comfort to read about that time from Michael's perspective as for me, it was the saddest time of my life and still feels surreal. Beyond the chapter about Angelina, this book inspired me in ways I would never have imagined. From Michael's passion for everything he does, his art, his teaching, his compassion for his students, friends and his family. The way his life intertwines with so many other rich characters in his book and how he never judges people but instead learns their stories, talks to them, gets to know them. You'll learn about Michael's accomplishments in Art and teaching and you'll meet many of his students, colleagues, clientele and fellow artists. You'll also meet Lisa, Michael's wife and how together they fight for their son Carmen well being after being diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) and Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD). The first person I bought this book for, besides myself, was a dear friend who also happens to be a teacher. I think all teachers should read this book but I also think anyone and everyone should read this book!
