


The book was found

Synopsis

I'm reading this a chapter every night to my 7 year old daughter. It is sooooo interesting, and I'm constantly tempted to read ahead. I highly recommend this book to anyone. It sparks curiosity to

learn more about the several civilizations written about in the book, the history, the culture, yet it is an action-packed book that seems to have quite a bit of research put into it. The chapters are also not overwhelming to read out loud if you do end up using it as a read-aloud.

This was a reading assignments for our home school Co-op. My 11 yr old son enjoyed it. Some of the wording is harder but that didn't stop him reading the whole book in 2 weeks. I like that because we purchased it on the Kindle, when he had to look up a meaning of the word, he just clicked on it. (He already looks up words for other subjects in a book dictionary and not having to stop reading to look up a word is a great benefit to a struggling reader)

Coming-of-age, coming-to-kingship, and a cast of African, Egyptian, Israeli, Corinthian, and Assyrian characters. Historical novel set in the time of Sennacherib's seige of Jerusalem. Some scary stuff in the war -- they watch the fall of a besieged city and the mayhem afterward, the impalement of the warriors (not gory at all, Moms), and the terrified captives being led away. This book has a black Nubian king-Pharoah for a main hero -- plus, he's the child of a slave girl. It's great. My kids are pretty sheltered, but I have no qualms about reading this to them. (Author's notes give the scripture references in II Kings, Chronicles, and Isaiah for further reading.)

The characters were engaging and well shaped. The story is exciting to the last. Nothing was boring. I love historical fiction & this book will be on my favorites list! Couldn't put it down! All ages would enjoy this book - abt 10 to 110! Some gruesome descriptions might scare little kids. 5 stars because it's worth a read!!

I'm always looking for some high interest historical fiction to supplement my Ancient Civilization class. This was a good read that I think my boys and girls will enjoy. I know I did! I'll use as an introduction to our Ancient Egypt studies. I've been to Thebes and it is "spot on."

This page-turner, set in Biblical times, this book offers religious connections while avoiding being overtly "preachy." It would be of interest to anyone looking for excellent historical fiction about the BC era in which African leaders ruled Egypt and the Assyrians conquered the Middle East. Truly, Ms. Williamson has a gift for bringing history to life in a way that will inspire young people. I would recommend it for grades 5 and up.

This well written story is engaging for children and adults alike. The author's use of Biblical scripture on which to build her story makes the reading even more relevant. Her blend of Biblical events and fictional embellishments is masterful. I would recommend reading the story and then reading the Biblical accounts.
