Loved it. Interesting and well written if you are a fan of the show. This would have been the best episode of the series.

The well-crafted TNT series Falling Skies begins about 6 months after an alien attack destroyed 90% of humanity. Fans of the show have many questions about the events that occurred before we meet the show's characters. This graphic novel answers many fan questions, providing a detailed glimpse into the lives of the characters before the start of the series. The novel is well-written and stays firmly within the mythology of the show, as well as capturing the essence of the characters. Previously, much of this material was available via a link to a comic book series on the Falling Skies website. While this novel is primarily aimed at existing fans of the show, it would also make an absorbing introduction to the story for those who enjoy sci-fi drama but have previously missed Falling Skies' first season.

I liked it, but not as much as the first one and it does not have to be read before viewing the second season. However, it does set things up rather nicely, although most of that will come to light on the show through the comments and conversations among and made by several different characters. Also, it seemed that the artwork looked a little different, at least in terms of the character matching their on-screen counterparts, but aside from that it was a great read. It also contains insight about what happened to Karen after she was taken, for those who wondered just how and why she became an agent for the Skitters. All in all it was nicely done.

This was an excellent graphic novel. It tells the story of the characters in the days just prior to the opening of the TV show. The art was well-done and the story is on par with the writing in the show. Additionally, there's a sketch book with notes from the artist at the end of the work. Highly recommended for fans of graphic novels and/or the show!

The artwork is stunning esp. how much the characters look like their on-screen counterparts. I also loved the bits narrated by Tom via his journal. Also, you may want to read the comic before you see the show esp. if you're a newcomer like me to this awesome series, as it reveals a lot about how the 2nd Mass came to be and how Ben came to be captured as well.
