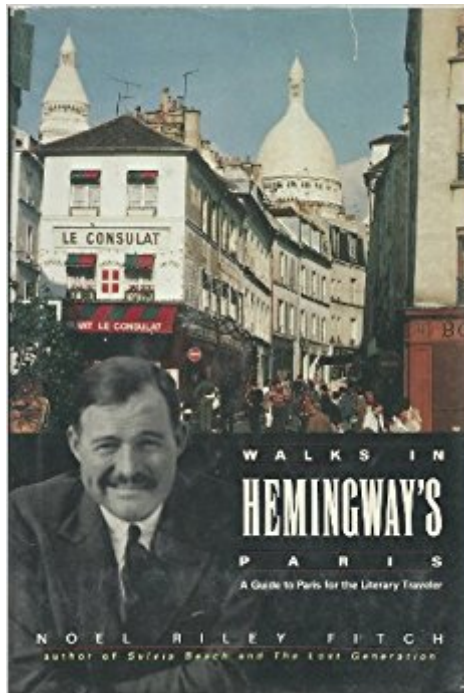




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Walks In Hemingway's Paris: A Guide To Paris For The Literary Traveler
