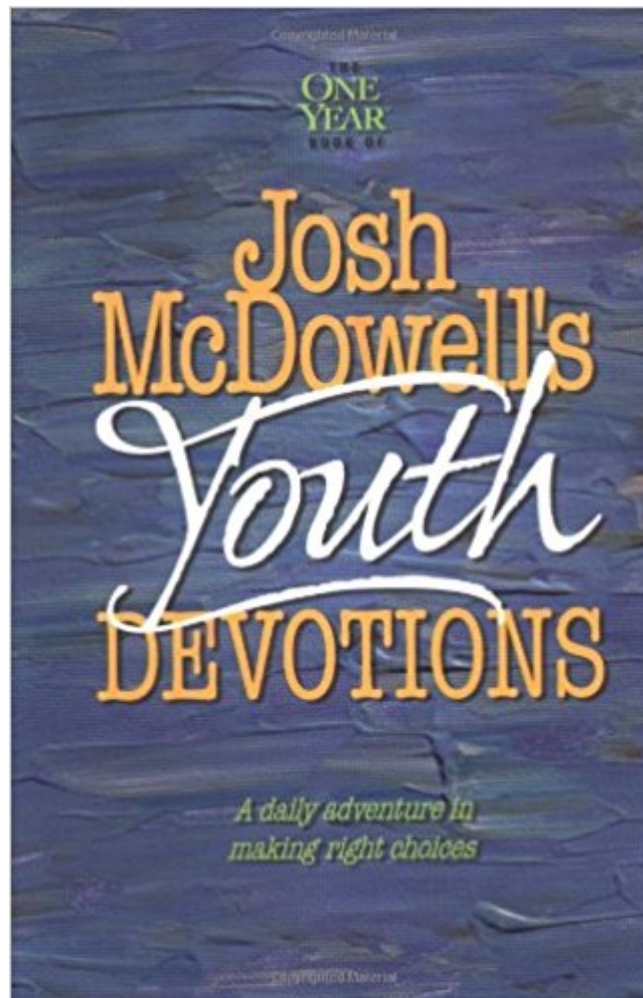




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The One Year Josh McDowell's Youth Devotions

I purchased this book for my Confirmation class. Each week one of the girls will take the book home and find a devotion they like and read it in class the following week. They like that the stories relate to things that truly go on in their lives. We almost always get into a discussion either with the story itself or with the question to ponder at the end. The prayer at the end always relates well to the

story. I think it works really well in this setting.

I am reading this daily (well almost daily), with my son. It is very well written and an excellent devotional that we can do together or individually. There is plenty of depth and thought that went into this book. Josh McDowell is great and this devotional will really make your child think. I would recommend this for 12 and up if they are reading it alone by themselves but it is something that is great to do as a parent/child devotional. In that case I would say that even 8 years old would not be too young to get started with this devotional. I've learned a lot from it myself and I am almost 60.

This is the first devotional book that my 11-year-old has enjoyed. He actually looks forward to reading it each day. He's a typical spongebob-watching, mp3-listening, psp-playing pre-teen, so a Christian devotional book holding his attention like this is a Godsend. Highly recommended!

My son and I read this together at night. It's started some really amazing conversations between us. Definitely recommend!

Wonderful! Our son has it by his bed and reads the short story usually before he goes to sleep. He'll say, "You know a funny or interesting story from my book.....". We have great conversations that he initiates, and that my friend is, AWESOME!
