

Synopsis

Lizzie and Karl's mother is a zoo keeper; the family has become attached to an orphaned elephant named Marlene, who will be destroyed as a precautionary measure so she and the other animals don't run wild should the zoo be hit by bombs. The family persuades the zoo director to let Marlene stay in their garden instead. When the city is bombed, the family flees with thousands of others, but how can they walk the same route when they have an elephant in tow, and keep themselves safe? Along the way, they meet Peter, a Canadian navigator who risks his own capture to save the family. As Michael Morpurgo writes in an author's note, *An Elephant in the Garden* is inspired by historical truths, and by his admiration for elephants, "the noblest and wisest and most sensitive of all creatures." Here is a story that brings together an unlikely group of survivors whose faith in kindness and love proves the best weapon of all.

My fifth graders love it! It is a beautifully written book and they have kept it checked out continually. For a book to hold a 10 year old’s attention without benefit of battles or vampires is so refreshing in today’s market. My class highly recommends it!

I bought this book because I love both the city of Dresden and the book *Water for Elephants*. Not much of Dresden is in the setting, and the plot is not as complex as *Water for Elephants*. Still, the book is an excellent read-aloud for upper elementary students because of the elephant’s appealing character and the suspense of the family’s wartime journey to Heidelberg. I also noticed a connection to the von Stauffenberg plot to assassinate Hitler. The Countess’s castle is in about the right place on the journey, but it is a parallel rather than a reference because Von Stauffenberg’s wife was arrested after her husband was executed. The compass is an important symbol in the book, and there is a lot of opportunity for students to debate ethical choices.

I tried to stop reading six different times! Finally it became apparent that I could not stop. So, here I am at 1:24 AM writing this review. My advice? Start reading it with your coffee at breakfast.
