

Really small, almost irritatingly tiny book (guess that's why they call it the "pocket" guide). Densely packed with info but I was a little disappointed that there were no photos or illustrations to identify unknown pills.

Pocket size, didn't like the small size at first, now can't work without it. Has alphabetical list of brand and generic drugs, includes black box warnings. Takes less time to look up than internet.

Good book, good info, BUT very small and students complain hard to read. Can hold in palm of your hand. Fits nice in uniform pocket and not as heavy as the fatter version.

Really!? I start off studying 24 of the most common meds given last year and was only able to find 23 of them. Too bad I didn't try a small Davis guide, that big one just doesn't fit in my scrubs pocket.
