

Every one of the Mike Kraus books I have read..(and that is all of them have been great. Can't wait for the next one to come out.

The Burning Fields is the fifth book in the Surviving the Fall series. This can be read as a standalone but should not be. It will make more sense if you have read the first four books plus it has a cliffhanger ending. There is a lot of violence, it is an apocalyptic thriller, so it might not be suitable for more sensitive readers. The book blurb adequately describes the storyline so I'm not going to repeat all of that info here. This is an apocalyptic thriller filled with people trying to survive in a country and world gone crazy. This story includes a lot of twists and turns. As usual, everything is not as it seems. I look forward to reading more of this series. My only complaint is that these are short episodes. You just get really engaged in the story and characters and you are to the cliffhanger and have to wait for the next one to be published. But they are so good, and the author writes them fairly quickly so you don't have to wait too long. I received a copy of this story from the author and chose to leave a review for other readers.

Wow! Dianne is in Virginia with their two children. Mark is maturing and Dianne is finding herself relying upon him more and more. The guys that tried to steal her truck earlier are spotted in the area and seem to have friends. Dianne is an experienced prepper. She's familiar with guns and doesn't panic, but the world is a very dangerous place for an attractive woman and two children. Still there is a chance to recruit some help. Rick is still a long way from home and it seems nothing is going right. He has to keep moving, not knowing if his family is safe, making it back to Virginia is all he can think of. He is faced with a situation so hopeless that it briefly shakes his hope and faith of the future. Sometimes the biggest holdup in his progress comes when he makes contact with the good guys. I need the next book!

As usual, Mike Kraus manages to pack the episodes of this series with suspense and action. Rick is still on his way home to Virginia, but runs into the army in Colorado. Will this be a deterrent to his journey? Diane discovers old friends who need help, which she's more than happy to offer. In the meantime, danger is rearing its head near her with the appearance of a gang of looters. I need the next episode, Mr. Kraus!

I usually don't read short stories that often, rarely actually, but I definitely do not mind making an exception for Mike Kraus books. He is an exceptional writer. This post apocalyptic book is about one families survival in a world gone wrong and most definitely mad. Only the father has been separated from his wife and children so you get back and forth views of whats going on. The story is not only good but also a possibility for our future and the characters so believable. I am looking forward to the next installment.

Mike Kraus doesn't disappoint in book 5 of this ongoing Surviving The Fall series. What an adventure! He is able to continue the story of Diane without boring the reader. She is in the Virginia just trying to survive with her children until Rick can find his way back home. Well written, but it does end on a cliffhanger. I'm anxiously awaiting book 6! I received this as an arc from the author and am loving this series. I review voluntarily and give my own opinion - this is great!

This fifth novella in this series does not disappoint. The adventure continues as Rick continues his journey home to be reunited with his family in Virginia.
