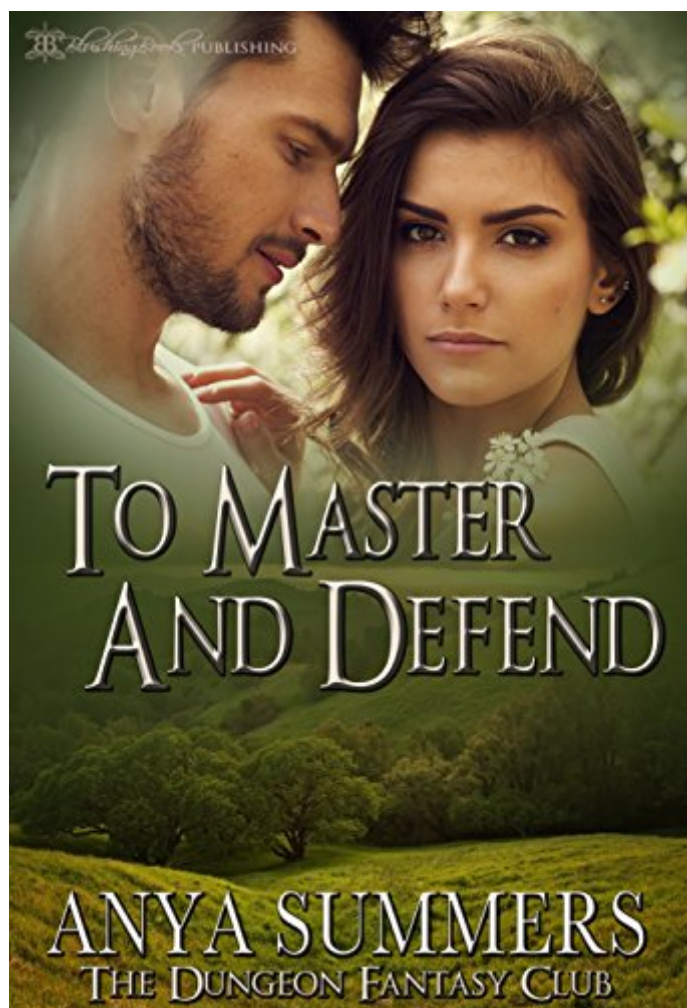


The book was found

This second book in the Master and Defend series by Anya Summers is a winner. Ophelia Mills was convinced by friends to attend a masquerade ball. Unbeknown to Ophelia it was held in a sex club, the Dungeon Pleasure. Ophelia has led a sheltered life up to now and wants one night of no strings attached sex. Most of her time is spent with her head in books. While at the ball Ophelia is saved by Tobias, after being attacked. Tobias is a Dom and the owner of the club. They have one wild night of great sex. The next morning Ophelia has second thoughts and sneaks out. Toby has no way of contacting her but is surprised when they meet again in the wilds of Scotland. Ophelia needed to visit her big sister, Zoey, as she finds herself in a difficult situation. The consequences of the night with Tobias is life changing. Zoey is engaged to Declan, the master of Mullardoch Manner and a Dom. Ophelia wanders into the dungeon in the middle of a scene between Zoe and Declan. She is shocked and tries to intervene. Tobias punishes Ophelia. The sex between Ophelia and Tobias is explosive. Ophelia is frightened by this and runs again. Ophelia is thrown into BDSM without really understanding it. This book has hot sex, spankings, anal sex and strong alpha males. It is well written and flows well. It was interesting reading the internal conflict Ophelia experiences. I was given this book for a honest review.

I really have liked the other books in the series, but this one...the other characters' reactions to Lia in a dungeon scene, and after an argument just really...felt sour. Characters I normally love seemed to be so self righteous and obtuse. I really think the heroine had valid points, but she is painted as being completely in the wrong, even dealing with things after being attacked, and she apologized for things that really aren't her fault. I think I'll delete this book, definitely not one I'll read again. The make up conversation was quite awkward, and it really didn't fit.

This was definitely a good read, but it could have been so much more. For instance, Lia learning about the lifestyle. He expected her to just go along with it, but never taught her anything. No discussion on limits or safe, sane and consensual. He just flipped her over and spanked her without any aftercare. This book had potential, in the end it was just mediocre.
