What a great find. I have gone on a similar journey searching for myself (israel) and leaving 6 months later dissatisfied with my search for God and the meaning of life. I like how mara asks many different kinds of people about their search for meaning in India and the conclusions she makes. It made my inability to find truth make a lot more sense.

In *Bag of Meat on Ball of Dirt*, Altman follows her curiosity around the phenomenon of traveling to a distant place to "find oneself." She is an ideal guide for this journey: she is not wrapped up in an existential crisis of her own, she is a seasoned writer well-equipped to handle the complexities inherent in meaning making and, most importantly, she is a captivating storyteller (I sat down to read this and only got up once because I really had to pee). One of the most refreshing aspects of *BMBD* is that it is not about the age-old trope of a woman finding meaning through her relationship to a man (Altman is happily married and her husband is chilling back in NYC while she is on this quest). Rather, Altman transcends gender through charting her own journey: a quest to unravel the universal desire to understand what it means to be human. And she does so in a way that is relatable, honest and hilarious. I highly recommend!

I read this single over 2 lunch breaks and had a grand time. The author is funny as hell sharing her adventures in India exploring the "spiritual tourist" phenomenon. As a spiritual seeker I really appreciate the hilariously clear mirror in this story. It helped remind me to celebrate the sheer perversity of existence.

I loved this story. It is so full of vivid imagery and interesting observations about traveling in India and the battle to figure it all out. The parade of characters whom the author encounters is endlessly entertaining. They made me feel, and truly believe, that finding oneself is really hard work, but a noble and worthwhile pursuit nonetheless.

Mara Altman has a wonderful way of bringing her experiences to the forefront of your own mind. Not only do we get to know what India must be like, but also the characters who live there. What we find in the end, is that each person's point of view about the same question makes complete

sense....until you hear and understand the next point of view.

Mara is one of those rare authors whose got it all: Heart, mind and humor. I love her style. This book is a must read for anyone who has ever tried to find themselves. Which is everyone. So read it. You must! :)
