

Glenn Harvey has specialized in photographing the lives of the British Royal Family; he has been awarded and acclaimed for his photographic work featuring Princess Diana and other members of the Royal Family. His work has been published worldwide, regularly appearing in Time and Life magazines. He is the author of Diana: A Princess Remembered. Mark Saunders was royal correspondent for the Windsor Express, the Queen's local newspaper, for five years. In that role he covered more than 200 official royal functions. Harvey and Saunders are the coauthors of Diana and the Paparazzi.

The book is divided into 5 walking tours around London- one map to each section. Each "walk" has numerous points of interest (many of which only the most dedicated Diana person will have heard about) with 2 or 3 (?) pages of text and a related photograph. The descriptions end with directions to

each location, I assume those are based on the relevant map. There's a section about additional places and people of interest at books end. If I ever get back to London this book will be worth something for major points of interest such as Palaces and the Memorial fountain. There's so much here, and some of it little known, that the average person would never have time to see it all unless they lived in London.

Excellent book for Diana fans! I lived in London back in the 1980s, but I had no idea so much went on behind the scenes. Not all the details mentioned in the book made it to the tabloids. The book appears to be well researched. I highly recommend this book for a light read.
