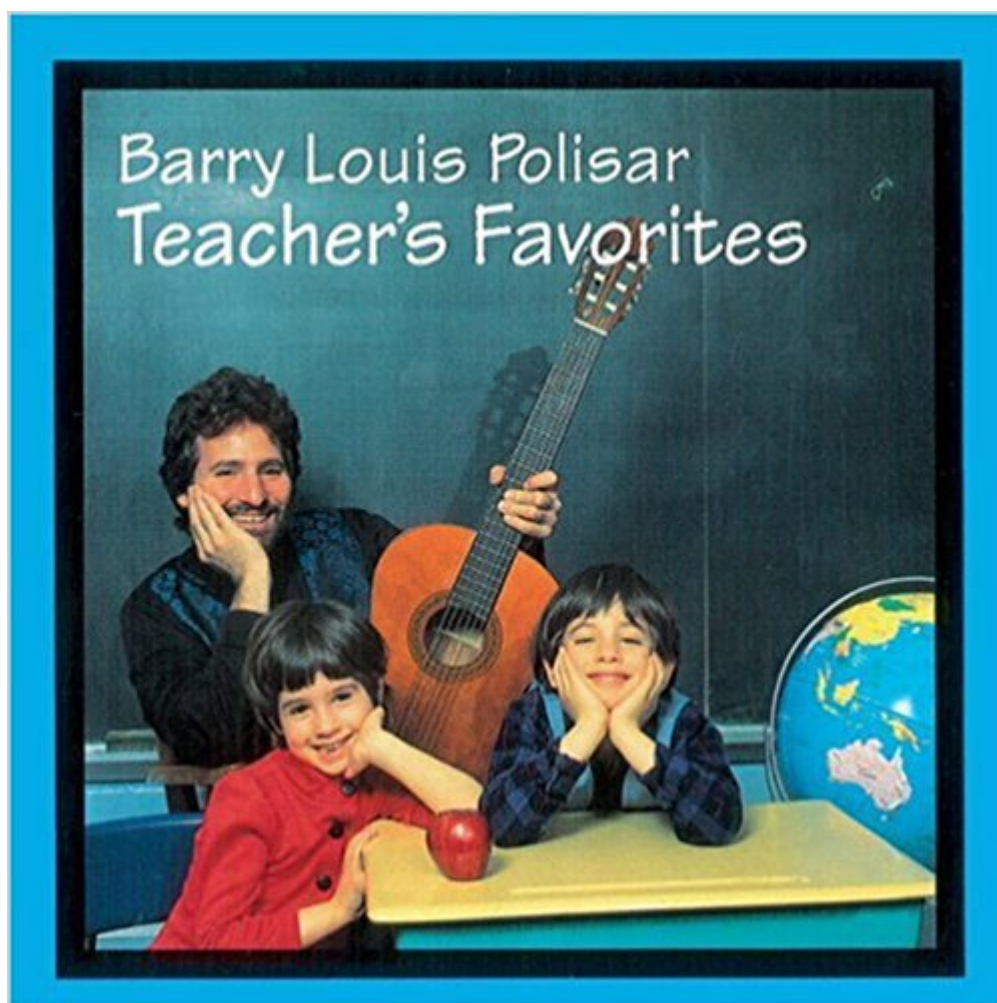

"Instead of an apple this year, give your favorite teacher Barry Louis Polisar's new hit package, Teacher's Favorites. This volume contains 13 school related songs. The production quality is outstanding. The guest musicians use guitars, mandolins, fiddles, dulcimers, slide guitar, clarinet and percussion to give the sound a richness not found in most children's recordings. Polisar's vocals are very playful. On the song "Nothing," a child's answer to the parental question, "What did you do today?", Polisar lays down some delightful back-up vocals with his six year old twins. He also uses some inventive multi-track vocals of himself on "I Lost My Pants," a song about the dilemma of getting ready for school. Other highlights include, "I Don't Wanna Go to School," with a surprise

ending that will be a hit with all school principals; “The Alfabet Song,” which includes words not found in most ABC books; and “Don’t Eat The Food That is Sitting on Your Plate,” a song sure to be a hit in the school cafeteria.
