

This book has a lot of info necessary for the care of Bonsai trees. Even though our Hawaiian Umbrella Tree was not in the guide. Our other tree was and it gave us some useful tips on how to care for it. It also has a lot of info on trimming, shaping and pruning as well a section on where to keep your Bonsai, root pruning and repotting and shaping with wire. It also has a section on things to know before you buy and a section on pests and diseases. and how to identify and treat problems. I highly recommend this book.

This book is in easy to read, outline form and includes the care for most bonsai... indoor and outdoor. It gives specific instructions for repotting, trimming, fertilizing and treating insect problems. The book is amazingly thorough. My only complaint is that I also bought a so-called money tree and it is not included in this book at all. This was not a huge problem as there are internet sites that talk about money trees. All in all I found this to be quite a valuable book and my tea tree seems to be doing quite well.
