

John Evans has over 25 years' experience in digital graphics, initially as a graphic designer and digital illustrator, and then as a multimedia author, user interface designer, and technical writer. He is the author of several editions of Peachpit's Adobe Photoshop Elements Classroom in a Book and Adobe Photoshop Lightroom Classroom in a Book, and he resides in Thailand. Katrin Straub is an artist, designer, and author who holds degrees from the FH Augsburg, ISIA Urbino, and The New School University in New York. She has authored many books, among them Adobe Creative Suite Idea Kit, Adobe Soundbooth CS3 Classroom in a Book and several versions of Adobe Photoshop Elements Classroom in a Book, Adobe Premiere Elements Classroom in a Book, and Adobe Photoshop Lightroom Classroom in a Book. She resides in Brussels, Belgium.

As a photographer, I know Photoshop like the back of my hand, but was never formally taught Lightroom. I like John Evans books as he is very detailed, easy to understand, lots of diagrams and photos, well-explained, not a beginners book but not for the seriously advanced either. For those like me who had some knowledge of the product, although you could learn the program from zero knowledge with this book, but if you know the program and are looking for some thing more advanced, This is an intermediate level text book.

I like the way the CIB series walks you through the lessons step by step. Some of the exercises, like sending a picture out of LR by email can have problems unrelated to the book, but dependent on your mail system. Also, had some problems with the exercise on sharing LR images with my Android phone, again this could be somewhat related to my phone. I think the book is expensive, but in the absence of anything better, the step by step instructions are very good and work well.

Not as good as I expected it to be. I liked that you are able to download images to work along with the lessons, but I thought the lessons could have been better. I found the lessons that I have done so far have shown how to adjust the photos without explaining why. I am only on chapter 6, so I will update my review once I have completed the book.

Still working my way through, but very helpful

As always, Adobe's Classroom in a Book series is excellent. It gives you the basics of how the

program works in a classroom setting with questions and answers so that you know what to expect when you begin working on your own images.

Book is well written but at times find it easier to follow a tutorial on YouTube.

Mostly the same text as previous versions, but worth it for all of the updates
